This book argues that the creation of the Canadian and American border dividing Indigenous territories required the categorizing of Indigenous nations using the construct of race.

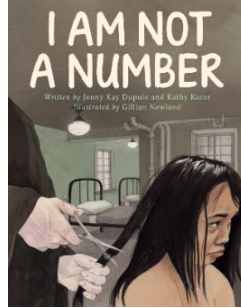

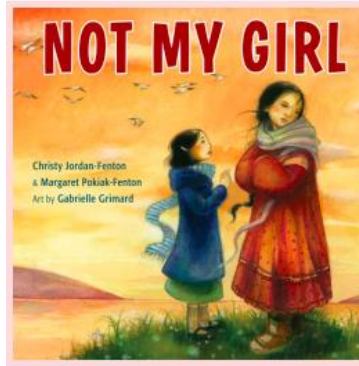

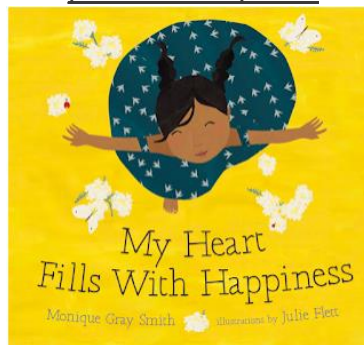
